As per IWRA reports India and China will suffer from sevir draughts in the coming 20 years, if conservation is not done properly”.

He explained about: 01. Distribution of water on the Earth, 02. Water on Earth and Fresh water, 03. Population Vs Water resources, 04. Global water problems, 05. Water conservation and Management, 06. Rain water harvesting techniques and 07. Domestic water wastage and replacement of machines.

Speaker answered the questions raised by the participants.






