

POST MATRIC SCHOLARSHIPS (RTF)/(MTF)

(a)Eligible Students:

The students under the following categories are eligible for availing the Schemes.

1. All the students, pursuing Polytechnic, Degree (B.Tech) level courses in Government/Aided/Private colleges, affiliated to State Universities / Boards.
2. Day scholar students, students in College Attached Hostels (CAH) and Department Attached Hostels (DAH).
3. 75% of the aggregate attendance is mandatory for release of scholarships.

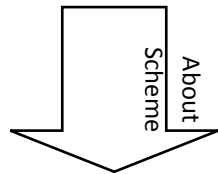
(b) In - eligible Students:

The students under the following categories are not eligible for availing the Schemes.

1. Studying in Private Universities / Deemed Universities.
2. Pursuing Correspondence / Distance education courses.
3. Admitted under Management / Spot Quota.

(c) Income Eligibility:

1. The total family annual income to be less than or equal to Rs.2.50 lakhs.
2. The total land holding of the family to be less than 10.00 acres of wet or 25.00 acres of dry or 25.00 acres both wet and dry land together.
3. No member of the family should be a government employee/ pensioner (all sanitary workers irrespective of their salary/ recruitment, are eligible. The Social Welfare Department shall develop a robust & fool-proof system of certification of parents of the beneficiaries under category of "Sanitary workers").
4. No member of the family should own a four-wheeler (Taxies/Tractors/Autos are exempted).
5. A family who owns no property or less than 1500 Sqft of built up area (Residential or Commercial) in urban areas is eligible.
6. No member of the family should be an income tax payee.



The Government of Andhra Pradesh have decided to implementing the Post Metric Scholarships scheme, to all eligible students belonging to the SC, ST, BC, EBC (other than Kapu), Kapu, Minority, Differently Abled categories, on a saturation basis.

The disbursal of scholarship is categorized into two schemes:

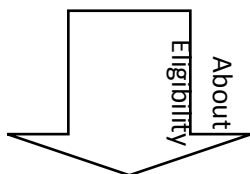
RTF:

To provide full fee reimbursement to every eligible student, i.e.Full Fee (Tuition Fee) as defined in the G.O.Ms.No.66 SW(Edn) Dept., dated 8-9-2010 and as fixed by the competent authorities

is reimbursed to all eligible students. i.e., Full fee shall be credited to the respective College accounts on behalf of students.

MTF:

To provide Rs.15,000/- per person to Polytechnic students, Rs.20,000/- per person for other Degree (B.Tech) and above courses per year to every eligible student for food and hostel expenses. MTF shall be credited into the respective account of the mother of the eligible student. In case of the demise or absence of the mother, the amount shall be credited to the account of the natural guardian of the student.



(a) Eligible Students:

The students under the following categories are eligible for availing the Schemes.

1. All the students, pursuing Polytechnic and Degree & above level courses in Government/Aided/Private colleges, affiliated to State Universities / Boards.

SWANATHSCHOLARSHIPSCHEMEFORSTUDENTS

1.0 OBJECTIVE OF THE SCHEME:

The Scheme is being implemented by AICTE to provide encouragement and support to orphans, wards of parents died due to Covid-19, wards of Armed Forces and Central Paramilitary Forces martyred in action (Shaheed) to pursue education. This is an attempt to give every such child, an opportunity to study further and prepare for a successful future through education in AICTE Approved institutions and courses.

2.0 ELIGIBILITY FOR SCHOLARSHIP:

1) The candidates should be from any one of the following categories:

(i) Orphan

OR

(ii) Either or both parents died due to Covid-19 OR

(iii) Wards of Armed Forces and Central Paramilitary Forces martyred in action (Shaheed) AND

2) Family income from all sources should not be more than Rs. 8 lakh per annum during the financial year of the application. A valid income certificate issued by State/UT Government is to be enclosed.
AND

3) The candidates should be currently studying in the AICTE Approved institutions and courses at Degree/

Diploma level in regular mode (in 1st/2nd/3rd/4th year). AND

4) The candidates should NOT be Recipient of any of the Central Govt./State Govt./AICTE Sponsored scholarships.

Note: Students who are satisfying conditions at S.No. 1, 2, 3 & 4 above are only eligible for this scholarship.

AICTE-PostGraduate(PG) Scholarship

Objectives of the Scheme:

AICTE in order to ensure development of technical education in India awards Post Graduate Scholarship of Rs. 12,400/- per month to full-time GATE/GPAT/CEED qualified students admitted to AICTE approved post graduate programs in AICTE approved Institutions/University Departments as per AICTE approved intake.

Amount of Scholarship:

The Scholarship under the scheme is Rs. 12,400/- per month per student.

Duration:

- a) The Scholarship is tenable for 24 months or for the duration of the course i.e. from the date of commencement of classes till the date of completion of the classes whichever is lower and is not extendable under any circumstances.
- b) Students of final years of dual degree integrated programmes would also be entitled to PG Scholarship from the 9th semester onwards in case they get a CGPA score of 8 or above (on a scale of 10) i.e. only for one year in final year.

Eligibility for Scholarship:

Post Graduate Scholarship is entitled only to those students:

- i) Having a valid GATE/GPAT/CEED score at the time of admission.
- ii) Must be admitted as a full-time scholar.
- iii) Students of final years of dual degree integrated programmes would also be entitled to PG Scholarship from the 9th semester onwards in case they get a CGPA score of 8 or above (on a scale of 10) i.e. only for one year in final year.
- iv) Admitted in AICTE approved Institutions/University Departments & AICTE approved programs viz. Master of Engineering, Master of Technology, Master of Architecture, Master of Pharmacy and Master of Design.
- v) Number of PG Scholarship is limited to the AICTE approved intake in the programme in that year. However in addition to the approved intake, AICTE will provide PG scholarship to the additional 10% candidates over and above the approved intake of that course from EWS category, if the university/ institute has admitted students from Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) as per MHRD OM F.No.12-4/2019-U1 dated 17th January 2019
